Chester N. Pizel, 75, Goodland, a retired Sherman County farmer, died Friday, Sept. 1, 2000, at Colwich Health Center in Colwich.

He was born Dec. 2, 1924, in Sherman County, the son of Rae Sybil (Hobbs) and Frank Pizel, Jr.

He attended Sherman County schools. While growing up, he helped with farming and raising his brothers and sisters.

He served in the U.S. Army in the Philippines during World War II.

He and Norma Richers were married April 11, 1944, at Mineral Wells, Texas, while he was still in the army.

After he returned from service, he farmed on the family homestead 14 miles north of Kanorado.

Milford W. Johnston

Milford Wayne Johnston, 76, a former longtime Goodland teacher, died Sunday, Sept. 3, 2000, at the Good Samaritan Center in Ellis.

He was born May 31, 1924, at Hoxie, the son of Gladys Marinda (Vinson) and Wayne Dew Johnston.

When he was three months old, his family moved to a farm near Zurich.

He attended West Sand Creek School in Rooks County, a one-room country school. He graduated in 1942 from Palco High School.

In the fall of 1942, as a freshman at Fort Hays State University, he com-

pleted a program that trained men to be naval officers. He began active duty on July 1, 1943, and was assigned to Southeastern Missouri State College at Cape Girardeau, Mo., for three semesters. Then after one semester of Midshipman School at Notre Dame University in Notre Dame, Ind., he received his commission as an ensign in the U.S. Navy. He served in the Pacific during World War II.

He received a bachelor's degree in mathematics and history in 1947 and a master's degree in physics in 1949 from Fort Hays State University.

He began teaching mathematics and physics in the fall of 1949 at Goodland High School. He retired May 30, 1986, after teaching for 37 years.

He was inducted into the Kansas Teacher Hall of Fame at Dodge City in 1987.

He and Claire Ann Kvasnicka were married June 2, 1951, at the Presbyterian Church in Hays.

He was a member of Sigma Pi Sigma, a national physics honor society; Delta Epsilon, a national mathematics society; the National Education Association; the Veterans of Foreign Wars; Fort Hays State University Alumni Association; and Goodland Retired Teachers.

His funeral will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Goodland with Pastor Scott Grimshaw officiating. Burial will follow in the Goodland Cemetery.

Friends may call from 4 to 8 p.m. Wednesday and from 8 to 11 a.m. Thursday at Koons Chapel in Goodland and before the service Thursday at the church.
