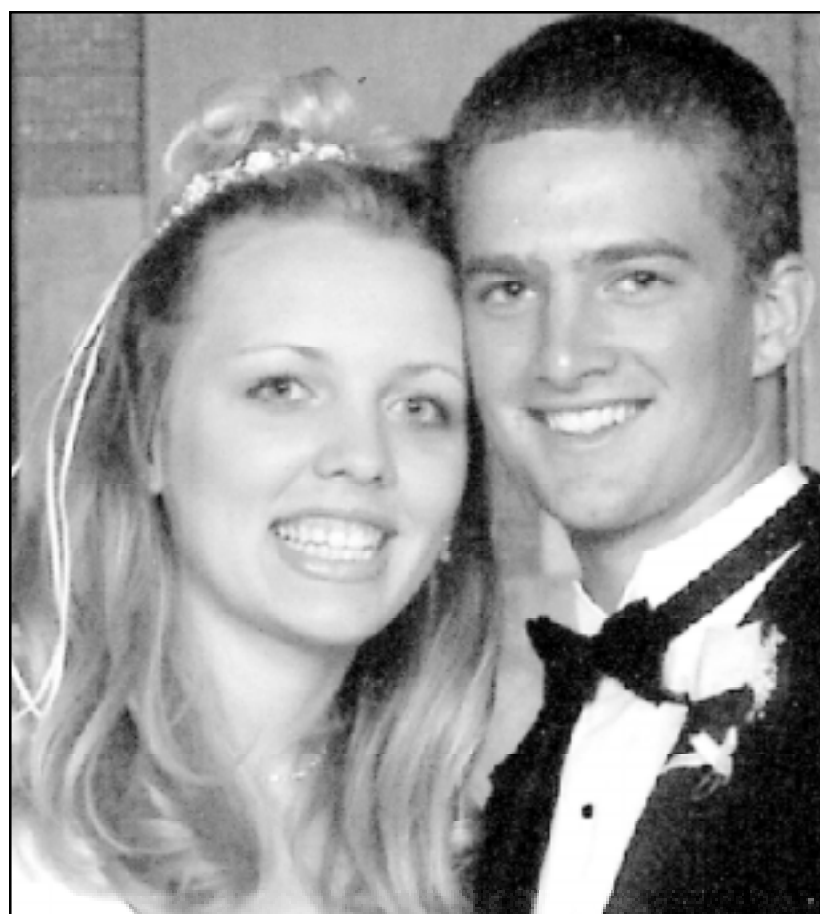
The girl's dresses were yellow chiffon over yellow satin with a scoop neckline and cap sleeves.
