

# Commissioners continue discussion on steps to take with airport hanger

Goodland city commissioners plan to continue discussions on the old hanger at the airport during their regular meeting Monday.

Last meeting the commission members talked about how run down the hanger is, and debated whether it should be torn down and replaced or just remodeled.

City Manager Ron Pickman said that

the commissioners would continue the discussion when they meet at 5 p.m. upstairs at the City Administration Building.

The commission will also vote on payment to Rhoads Construction Co. for its work on Steever Water Park.

Pickman said that work on the pool is moving along nicely. Workers are pouring concrete in the main pool.

The commission will look at bids for a new lawn mower and will consider home occupation special use permits for Charlotte Becker at 307 E. Third Street and Elizabeth Best at 307 West 10th Street for daycare facilities.

The commission plans a closed session to discuss the possible purchase of property.
