A RESOLUTION ATTESTING TO THE INCREASE IN TAXES LEVIED FOR BUDGET YEAR 2001 FOR THE COUNTY OF SHERMAN.

WHEREAS, the County of Sherman must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this county; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of Sherman County continues to increase; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Sherman County, Kansas:

Section One: In accordance with state law, Sherman County has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget

necessary to fund county services from January 1, 2001 until December 31, 2001.

Section Two: After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services, which are essential for the citizens of Sherman County, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount, which exceeds the 2000 budget.

Section Three: This resolution shall take effect after publication once in the official county newspaper.
