# Cosmosphere offers space camp for 4-H members

The Kansas Cosmosphere in Hutchinson will blast off its first Kansas 4-H Star Aerospace Experience on Nov. 17-19 in Hutchinson. It will include astronomy, hot air balloons, kites, aircraft, weather balloons, and space activities.

Only 225 youth ages 12 and above, as of Jan. 1, 2000, and 15 adult leaders

can attend.

The cost for youth is \$145 per individual and \$115 for an adult leader if paid by Saturday.

The cost of the program is kept low by using the 4-H Encampment Building at the Kansas State Fairgrounds for lodging and by getting meals from Hutchinson Community College.

The adult registration fee comes with expectations and responsibilities. Adult leaders will be asked to assist with the programs and maintain a healthy, caring and friendly environment in which youth can learn.
