Matron of honor was Leslie Fry, sister of the bride. Bridesmaids were Jamee Harrison and Lana Enfield, friends of the bride.

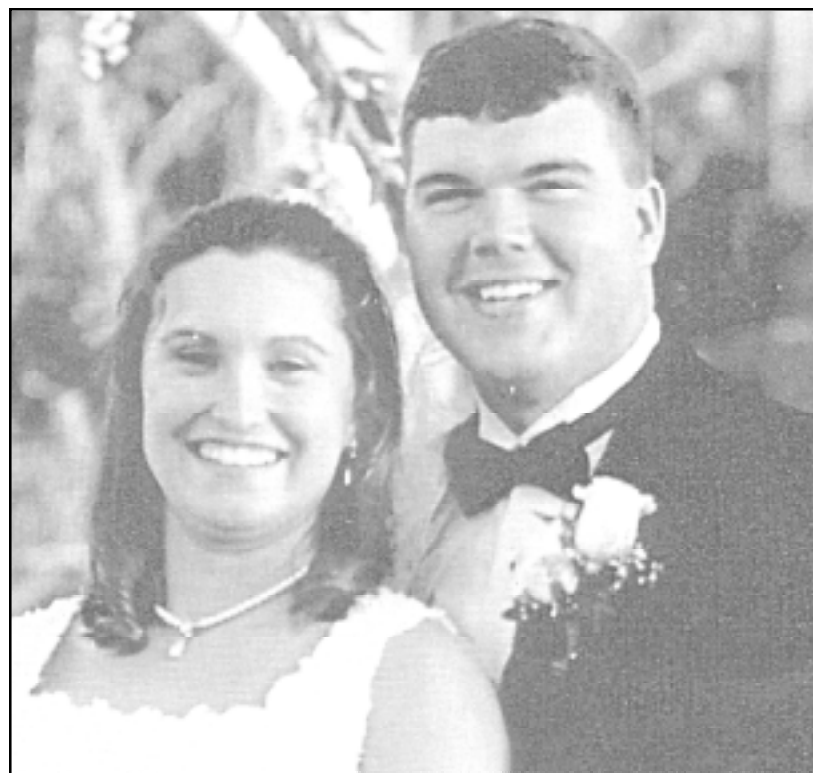
Flower girls were Taylor Milke, niece of the bride, and Danielle McNeely, sister of the groom.
