Kansas Lottery up for renewal

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — The Kansas Lottery will be renewed by lawmakers next year, but not without some wrangling, House Majority Leader Kent Glasscock says.

"That is going to be an issue that will be difficult to resolve," Glasscock, R-Manhattan, told *The Kansas City Star* editorial board on Monday.

The lottery generates about \$62 million in state revenues each year. Nearly half of that goes toward economic development.

The lottery will expire in 2002 unless the Legislature agrees to extend its life.

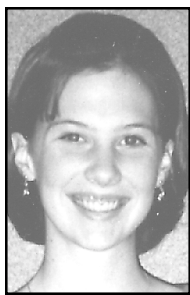

James "Smitty" Smith, newly-elected chairman of the three-person Democratic Party, said today that the committee plans to meet Monday and send off the nomination of Tiede next week. Gov. Bill Graves then has 10 days to make the appointment, or Tiede will automatically take the seat.
