**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A CERTAIN ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS.**

**SECTION 1.** The following street alley right-of-way is hereby vacated pursuant to K.S.A. 12-504.

A tract of land being a twenty and eighteen hundredths (20.18) foot alley in Block One (1) of the McFadden Subdivision to the City of Goodland, Kansas, bounded on the East by Eastridge Drive and on the West by the north/south alley between 10th Street and 11th Street, bounded on the North by Lot 2 and on the South by Lots 1 & 3 as platted in the McFadden Subdivision to the City of Goodland, Sherman County, Kansas, on Plat Book 3, Pages 7-8, now in Folder No. 28 all as filed February 25, 1975, in the office of the Register of Deeds of Sherman County, Kansas.

**SECTION 2.** The City of Goodland hereby reserves unto itself a utility easement and drainage easement in the above described tract.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.
