A PERMANENT EASEMENT for controlled access highway right of way and removal of borrow material over and upon a tract of land in the Southwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 8 South, Range 39 West of the 6th P.M., described as follows: BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of said Quarter Section; FIRST COURSE, thence on an assumed bearing of North 02 degrees 34 minutes 02 seconds East, 808.155 meters (2651.43 feet) along the West line of said Quarter Section to the North line of said Quarter Section; SECOND COURSE, thence South 87 degrees 41 minutes 29 seconds East, 22.633 meters (74.26 feet) along said North line; THIRD COURSE, thence South 02 degrees 37 minutes 30 seconds West, 201.808 meters (662.10 feet); FOURTH COURSE, thence South 01 degree 00 minutes 03 seconds East, 80.127 meters (262.88 feet); FIFTH COURSE, thence South 03 degrees 59 minutes 57 seconds West, 121.951 meters (400.10 feet); SIXTH COURSE, thence South 01 degree 07 minutes 57 seconds West, 243.932 meters (800.30 feet); SEVENTH COURSE, thence South 04 degrees 50 minutes 57 seconds West, 144.916 meters (475.45 feet); EIGHTH COURSE, thence South 88 degrees 15 minutes 44 seconds East, 109.909 meters (360.59 feet); NINTH COURSE, thence South 71 degrees 19 minutes 49 seconds East, 26.106 meters (85.65 feet); TENTH COURSE, thence South 01 degree 55 minutes 47 seconds West, 9.144 meters (30.00 feet) to the South line of said Quarter Section; ELEVENTH COURSE, thence North 87 degrees 49 minutes 57 seconds West, 159.792 meters (524.25 feet) along said South line to the point of beginning. The above described tract contains 2.287 hectares (5.65 acres), which includes 2.016 hectares (4.98 acres) of existing right of way, resulting in an acquisition of 0.271 hectare (0.67 acre), more or less.

Lands abutting said highway shall have no right or easement of access thereto, provided, however, that the remaining lands shall abut upon and have access to said highway over and across the following described courses: All of said 'THIRD', and 'FOURTH', courses; ALSO beginning at the end of said 'EIGHTH' course and extending North 88 degrees 15 minutes 44 seconds West, 10.000 meters (32.81 feet).

4. That pursuant to K.S.A. 68-412 and K.S.A. 68-406, the City of Goodland, Kansas has entered into an agreement with the Secretary of Transportation for the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of a city connecting link within its corporate limits. That the City has seen and approved the plans for the project. The City, pursuant to its agreement set forth herein, verifies the Petition, and that it has requested the Secretary of Transportation to acquire this property. It also affirms the fact that the project is necessary for city connecting link purposes, and that the interests in real property set forth herein are required by the City and the Kansas Department of Transportation.

5. That no right, title, or interest in or to the oil and gas minerals, under or in the lands described herein is to be condemned.

6. That the plaintiff may construct and maintain a five-strand barbed wire fence or higher type on each side of the highway right of way where access to the highway is to be controlled. Any fencing installed will be constructed within the boundaries of the highway right of way and adjacent to the properties owned by the parties named herein abutting the right of way. The plaintiff will allow abutting landowners to pasture against the fence; provided, however, that the plaintiff assumes no responsibility for restraining the livestock of abutting landowners and assumes no liability or legal responsibility for fencing private property.

7. Access to the property shall be afforded in an adequate and satisfactory manner by the contractor at all times during the period of temporary construction easement taking. Landowners shall continue to have the right of ingress and egress over and across temporary construction easements, provided that a portion of the area may be closed for short periods of time while work is in progress in the immediate vicinity.

The owners, tenants and easement holders may fully use and enjoy the land within the temporary construction easement, provided such use shall not interfere with the construction of the improvement.

All areas disturbed will be restored by seeding or replacement of sod, or the placement of surfacing to a condition as good as, or better than before. No part of any building or structure, including any eaves, awnings or other overhang-

ing attachment, either within or partly within temporary easements shall be damaged or removed unless specifically stated. Access to the property will be maintained at all times except during actual entrance construction or reconstruction activities.

In the event the property has more than one entrance to be constructed or reconstructed, not more than one entrance to the property will be closed for the construction or reconstruction of the entrance at any one time. Temporary surfacing will be applied and maintained to allow access to the property during times of wet and rainy weather.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff prays that the Court find from this Petition that the plaintiff has the power to exercise the right of eminent domain for the purposes stated herein and that the titles or easements to or upon lands, or interests or rights therein, and other property and rights described herein are necessary to carry out the plaintiffs lawful powers and duties. The plaintiff further prays that such findings be entered of record and that an order be made appointing three disinterested householders of Sherman County to view and appraise the value of the titles or easements to or upon lands or interest or rights therein, and other property and rights described herein and to determine the damages to the parties named herein.

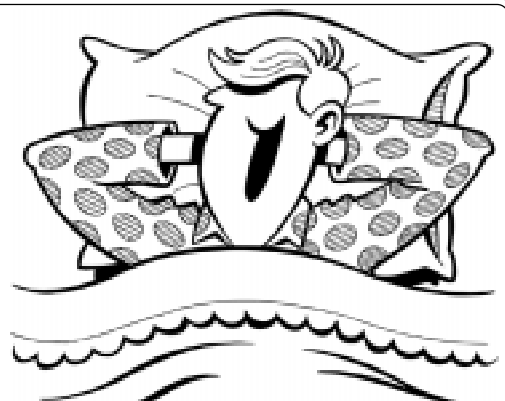
