

Cowboys face tough tourney

*Junior varsity
wrestlers learn
from facing
varsity teams*

The Goodland Cowboys junior varsity wrestling team had some tough competition from host Norton on Saturday when they traveled there for a "dual tournament."

"It was a great learning experience for the junior varsity," said Coach Chris Guillot. "The competition allowed them to see where they were at in relation to the varsity level."

Other teams at the meet were Oberlin and Herrington. Garden City was scheduled to be there, but didn't show. Goodland lost 43-34 to Herrington, 48-12 to Oberlin and 67-0 to Norton, all varsity teams.

Individual results for the Goodland team were:

103 pounds — Korey Schulte, freshman, had a bye against Herrington. Against Oberlin, Schulte fell in 3:18 to Shane Montgomery. In his Norton match, Schulte's J.B. Harding, Gray lost by a fall in 1:05 to Brett McChesney.

112 pounds — Mathias Goodley, sophomore, won by a score of 8-0 over Dusty Greenmeyer of Herrington. In his match with Oberlin's Brent Olson, Goodley lost a 11-0 decision. Against Norton's James Annon, he lost by a score of 16-1.

119 pounds — Nick Gray, junior, lost by a 13-1 decision over Tyler Bell of Herrington. He then went on to win against Matt Coleman in a 5-3 decision with three overtimes. In the match against Norton's J.B. Harding, Gray lost by a fall in 1:06.

125 pounds — Tyrel Rall, sophomore, lost in a close match with Drew Palmer of Herrington by an 8-6 decision. In his match with Oberlin's Chance Harman, he was pinned in :38. He took another fall in 1:49 against Kurtis Cambell of Norton.

140 pounds — Max Saint, junior, pinned Seth Tomkins of Oberlin in 1:05 in an exhibition match. He lost a 22-7 decision against Oberlin's Bryan Miller. He fell to Will Bolt of Norton in 1:20.

145 pounds — Chance Schilling, sophomore, won by a forfeit in his match with Herrington. He fell in his match against Grant Reichert of Oberlin. He also fell in 1:34 to Norton's Joe Bolt.

152 pounds — Brandon Linden, sophomore, fell to Herrington's Mitch Johnson. He fell in :39 to Brett Keck of Oberlin. He took another fall in 1:11 in his match with Tom Graham of Norton.

160 pounds — Adrian Hernandez, freshman, took a fall in 1:07 against Nick Herpich of Herrington. He fell in 1:07 to Oberlin's Tyler Cook. He also fell in 1:12 to Jon Haussermann of Norton.

171 pounds — Efrain Aguirre, freshman, pinned Greg van de Creek of Herrington in 1:35. He fell in :40 to Ryan Diedrich of Oberlin. He also fell in his match against Norton's Tim Sprigg.

275 pounds — A.J. Johnson, sophomore, fell in :42 to Sean Darby of Herrington. He won a 9-3 decision against Carman of Oberlin, who weighed 215 pounds. Johnson fell in 1:18 to Norton's Chuck Delimont.

130 pounds — Gage Cloyd, freshman, captured a fall against Jason Gregory of Herrington. He had another fall in :17 against Chase Juenemann of Oberlin. Then Cloyd fell to Eric Johnson of Norton.

135 pounds — Mike Zimmerman, freshman, fell to Jesse Biehler of Herrington. He lost a 15-4 decision against Jason Gallentine of Oberlin. He also lost a close match with Norton's

Jayhawks beat DePaul 75-69

CHICAGO (AP) — Kenny Gregory and Luke Axtell were out with injuries and No. 10 Kansas was coming off one of its worst losses, so Nick Collison responded with the best game of his college career.

"I was hoping I could step up. The team needed me to do that and I felt comfortable," Collison said Tuesday night when he scored a career-high 23 points as the Jayhawks rallied in the second half and beat DePaul 75-69.

"We had lost Kenny and then Luke got hurt and everybody was a little down," Collison said. "It was tough at first and then we just knew we had to regroup."

Gregory, the Jayhawks' leading scorer, sat out a second straight game with a stress fracture in his right foot, and then Axtell sprained his ankle in practice.

The Jayhawks, blown out by 31 points at Wake Forest last week — tying for the fourth-worst loss in

school history — rallied from a nine-point halftime deficit Tuesday night because DePaul (4-4) collapsed in the second half after leading scorer Bobby Simmons got in foul trouble.

"We were just really good in the second half," Kansas coach Roy Williams said.

"We got them to turn it over. Bobby Simmons almost shot us out of it. Obviously, the key point was getting him in foul trouble."


