

# Mustangs still undefeated

The seventh-grade Mustang basketball team held on to its undefeated season by winning at the Northwest Kansas League division tournament in Oberlin on Thursday.

The Mustangs won their first game against Oberlin 51-19 and the championship round against Oakley 51-31. They will play their last games of the season on Thursday at Hoxie for the league tournament playoff.

Against Oberlin, Bobby Miller had 20 points to lead the Mustangs. Jase Herl followed with nine. Other scorers were Jon Beeson (6), Wyatt Dautel and Brandon Zelfer (4), and Nick Howard, Derrick Fenner, Chris Baumfalk and Kalan Lambercht (2).

Leading in rebounds were Miller

with eight, and Dautel and Beeson with five.

Jase Herl had two steals and three assists to lead the floor game. Miller chipped in with four assists from the post position.

"We played good man-to-man defense, which held Oberlin to two points in the second half," said coach Wallace Hansen.

In the championship, the score was close during the first half. Seventh ranked Oakley wouldn't go away, with the score 25-18 at the half.

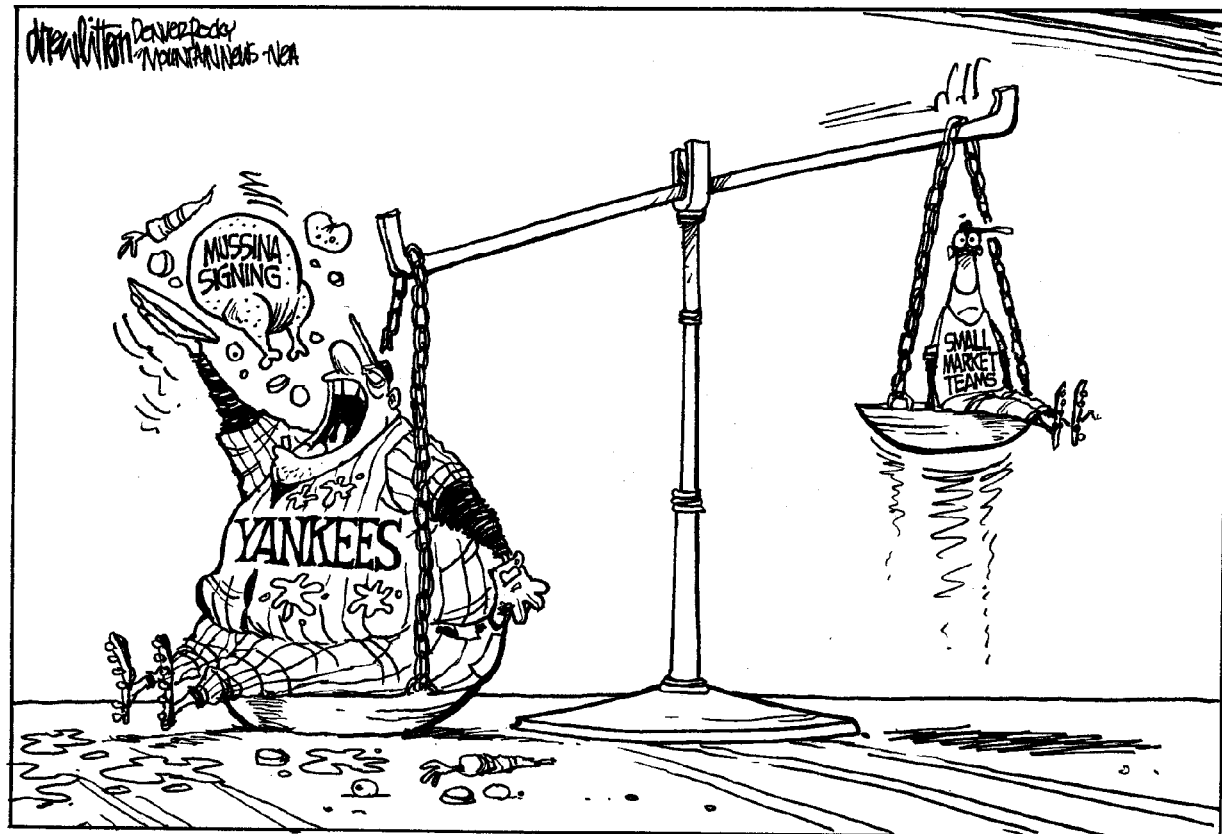
"The Mustangs played hard," the coach said, "and had some good defensive stops, and spurts of outstanding offense in the second half to outscore Oakley by 26-13."

Miller and Herl led scoring with 20 and 13 points respectively. Brandon Zelfer and Wyatt Dautel chipped in with seven and six points.

Rebound advantage went to Goodland with 28 to Oakley's 25. Miller and Beeson had eight and five rebounds each. Herl had six assists and two steals to lead the floor game.

In the two game tournament, said Hansen, nine players scored and 10 had rebounds or steals. The bench contributed nicely in both of the games, he said.

On Thursday, Goodland will play the second place-team from the other division and then, if successful, play the winner of the other bracket for the league championship.



# Eighth-grade team takes second

The Grant Junior High Mustangs eighth-grade team took second place at the Northwest Kansas league tournament on Thursday, losing to Hoxie in the championship round 40-36.

This was the second-to-last game of the season for the Mustangs. To get to the championship round, they beat Oberlin 53-13.

Derrick Raymer was the high scorer against Oberlin with 10 points, followed by A.J. Scields and David Livengood with eight each. Wade Taylor scored seven and Brock Lohr six; Lane Winter, Craig

Mason, Drew Wilkens four each and Joe Kaup two.

Lead rebounders were Taylor with nine and Drew Wilkens with four, while Kaup, Raymer and Bret Jarmin each got three and Livengood, Winter, Mason and Lohr one each.

On the defense side, Raymer led in steals and assists with six of each. Winter got four steals and four assists. Jarmin got two steals, Taylor got three, and Livengood, Mason and Lohr each got one. Livengood and Jarmin got one block each. Kaup and Taylor offered two assists with Raymer and Mason each giving out one

assist.

In the championship round, Wilkens led the team with eleven points. Raymer had nine, Taylor six points, Livengood five, Scields three and Winter two.

On rebounds Wilkens and Taylor each got seven, Lohr, Livengood and Raymer three and Kaup and Winter one apiece.

Livengood had three steals, Raymer two, and Lohr, Wilkens and Taylor one each. Wilkens made a block.

Leaders in assists were Winter and Wilkens with three, Livengood with two and Kaup with one.

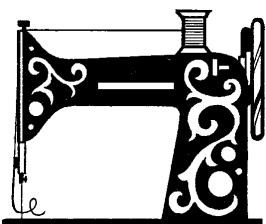

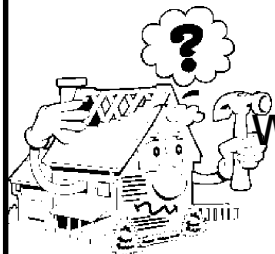

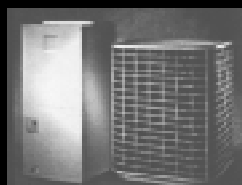
