## Library designates estate funds

The Goodland Public Library's Board of Trustees has designated \$30,000 of a \$31,433 bequest from the Floyd and Faye Blue estate for the Library Endowment Trust Fund and the rest of the money for equipment and furniture.

The Endowment Trust Fund was established in 1998 to help ensure the library's financial strength and stability. Money received as a contribution or bequest is added to the fund and will be used to expand and improve library services.

The Library Endowment Trust Board gave \$3,700 to the library at the end of 2000. Last year, income from the fund was \$2,500.

Members of the Library Board of Trustees include Mike Foust, Garey Brouillette, JoAnn Wahrman, Janice Minner, Lori Price, Maggie Hernandez and Jerry Fairbanks.

Lloyd Holbrook, Cara Daise, Larry McCants and Foust are members of the endowment trust board.


