KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) - Kansas State and Missouri have played basketball 212 times but never once when the Tigers were coming off a four-overtime epic.

"I hope they're tired," deadpanned Kansas State head coach Jim Wooldridge.

If the Tigers are mentally and physically fatigued for their Tuesday night appearance in Kansas State's Bramlage Coliseum, who could blame them?

They'll only be about 50 hours removed from playing the longest game in the school's 95-year basketball history. When the four-overtime thriller finally ended, Missouri had a 112-109 victory over defending Big 12 champion Iowa State and plenty of reason to
