

Mustang team takes first in Cheyenne Wells

The Grant Mustang wrestlers traveled to Cheyenne Wells Tuesday, Feb. 6, where they won the tournament and had six first place medal winners.

Thursday the Mustangs will travel to Colby for a triangular meet starting at 3:30 p.m. Mountain Time.

Justin Holloway, Craig Mason, Blake Saint, Drew Wilkens, David Livengood and Dexter Deeds were the first place finishers for Goodland.

Goodland won the tournament with a team score of 317.5 ahead of Burlington at 250 and Lamar at 234. Cheyenne Wells was fourth at 123, Goodland's second team was fifth at 104.5, sixth Eads 89; seventh Stratton 76; eighth Holly 57; ninth Wiley 40; and tenth Karval 18.


