Couple plan June wedding

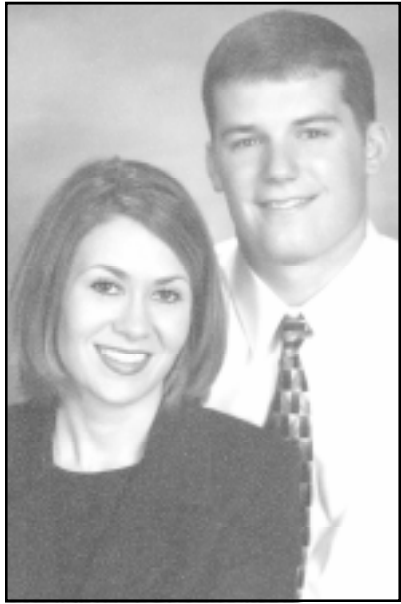
Angela Elaine Short and Benjamin John Labertew plan to be married June 30 at the First United Methodist Church in Goodland.


