



# Pitcher set for opener

HAINES CITY, Fla. (AP) — Jose Rosado — if he's healthy — is manager Tony Muser's first choice to start the Kansas City Royals season opener April 2 against the New York Yankees. Rosado has not pitched since April 30, when he won a 6-3 victory over Seattle. He had shoulder surgery in June to mend a cartilage tear and to clean up his rotator cuff. "Rosey will pitch the opener at Yankee Stadium, that's my goal," Muser said Thursday after practice. "If he's ready Opening Day to pitch, he'll pitch. If he needs an extra day, he goes the second day. "It's not a matter of if he's going to

pitch, but when." While the Royals are still a week away from their first exhibition game, Muser has been pleased with Rosado's progress and work habits. "He went through some pretty extensive drills for him today," Muser said. "He's sore, but a good sore. There's some stiffness and slight soreness, but it's a positive and not a negative." Rosado, 26, was 2-2 with a 5.86 earned-run average in five starts before the shoulder injury ended his 2000 season. He was the Royals' lone representative in the 1997 and 1999 All-Star games and was the winning pitcher in

1997. Rosado, however, has never started a season opener. Jeff Suppan was the Opening Day starter last year at Toronto after Rosado suffered a leg injury in spring training. "I'm working to be No. 1 on the staff," Rosado said. "That's the way anybody should be coming off surgery, try to be No. 1." Rosado's first career victory was July 25, 1996, at Yankee Stadium. He has a 2-5 career record against the Yankees, including a 7-1 loss April 15, 2000, at New York. Rosado gave up five runs on seven hits, including three home runs, in six innings.
