Scholarship applications needed

Scholarship applications are being accepted from high school seniors or college freshmen and sophomores majoring in journalism, political science or communications by the Kansas County Clerk's and Election Officials Association.

The money is made available by local election officials and state supervising judges, who are asked to report races in the general election to the Voters News Service. The service then pays the association for this work and the money is set aside for scholarships.

At the association's spring and fall seminars, homemade items brought by county clerks and election officials are sold at a silent auction. The

money made goes into the scholarship fund.

Due to the joint efforts of the county clerks, the secretary of state's office and the news service, the scholarship committee will be awarding scholarships worth \$500 each.

Applications may be picked up the Sherman County clerk's office and must be returned by April 1 to the county clerk or sent to Marilyn Horn, Box 28, Oberlin, Kan. 67749.

The scholarship winners will be announced at the association's seminar in May and scholarships will be presented to the winners by their county clerk at their school awards assembly.


