

# 'Dawgs earn fourth trip to state

COLBY — The Brewster Bulldogs beat their league rivals, the Weskan Coyotes, 80-56 in the championship game of the Class 1A sub-state tournament Saturday, earning them their fourth consecutive trip to state.

The first quarter found Brett Arnberger warming up the basket quickly for the Bulldogs, shooting 4 of 5 from beyond the arc.

At the end of the quarter, Brewster led 24-19.

At the half, the Bulldogs stood at 42-

35, increasing their lead to seven as they headed into the locker room.

In the third quarter, the 'Dawgs came out ready to play and their defensive game really picked up, allowing Weskan only four points in the eight-minute quarter.

Brewster scored 20 points. The Bulldogs led 62-39.

The final period saw Brewster's bench empty, giving valuable playing time to the younger players. The Bulldogs had defeated the Coyotes 80-56

when the dust had cleared.

Clint Horinek led Brewster with 19 points, four steals, two assists, and pulled down four rebounds.

Jay Reid and Brett Arnberger had 17 points each with Reid picking up a steal, two assists, and grabbed a team high six rebounds. Arnberger had three steals, three assists, and pulled down one rebound.

P.J. Crumbaker was the fourth Bulldog to score in double figures with 11 points, two steals, three assists, and

three rebounds.

Justin Jamison rounds out the starting five stats with 8 points, four assists, and one rebound.

Jacob Falcon had 4 points and four assists, while J.R. Baird scored 2 points.

Rob Garner finished the game with 2 points and two steals for Brewster.

The 'Dawgs will head to Hays for the state tournament on Thursday, with the game beginning at 6:30 p.m. Brewster will take on Baileyville B & B.

# Brewster boys capture sub-state title

COLBY — The Brewster Bulldogs captured another sub-state basketball title over the weekend, defeating Northern Valley and Western Kansas Liberty League rival Weskan.

On Friday, Brewster matched up against Northern Valley for their second time this year. The 'Dawgs jumped out early and led at the end of the first quarter 16-5. At the half, the boys led

27-13 as they headed into the locker room.

In the third quarter, the Brewster squad dominated the Almena crew, adding 27 points to their score while holding the Huskies to 15. They ended the period at 54-28.

The Brewster's bench saw lots of action in the third and fourth quarters while contributing 8 points to the

game. Brewster won 62-46.

Brett Arnberger led all scorers with 20 points, five steals, five assists and four rebounds.

Clint Horinek followed closely behind with 16 points, one rebound, one assist, and a team high eight rebounds on the night.

Jay Reid had 8 points, one steal, led the team with 6 assists, and pulled

down three rebounds. Justin Jamison and P.J. Crumbaker both had five points in the game. Jamison had two steals, two assists, and four rebounds while Crumbaker had a steal, three assists and grabbed one rebound for Brewster.

J.R. Baird recorded 6 points, while Bobby Tubbs had 2 points and two steals.

# No. 9 Jayhawks defeat Missouri Tigers, 75-59

LAWRENCE (AP) — As far as Roy Williams is concerned, Missouri has nothing to fear when NCAA bids are handed out next Sunday.

"I think they're already in," Williams said Sunday right after No. 9 Kansas took over in the second half and beat the Tigers 75-59.

"They've played a tremendous schedule and they have some great wins. They've got nine wins in this

conference. And that is very impressive. I don't think they're on the bubble at all."

One of the best wins for the Tigers (18-11, 9-7 Big 12) came in late January when they bested the Jayhawks 75-66. But a healthy Kareem Rush had 27 points and 11 rebounds that night. On Sunday, coming back from a seven-game layoff because of an injured thumb, the Big 12's leading scorer

played just 15 minutes and scored a season-low two points.

Toward the end, after Kansas point guard Kirk Hinrich banged into Rush's sore thumb, and he ran off the floor and into the locker room.

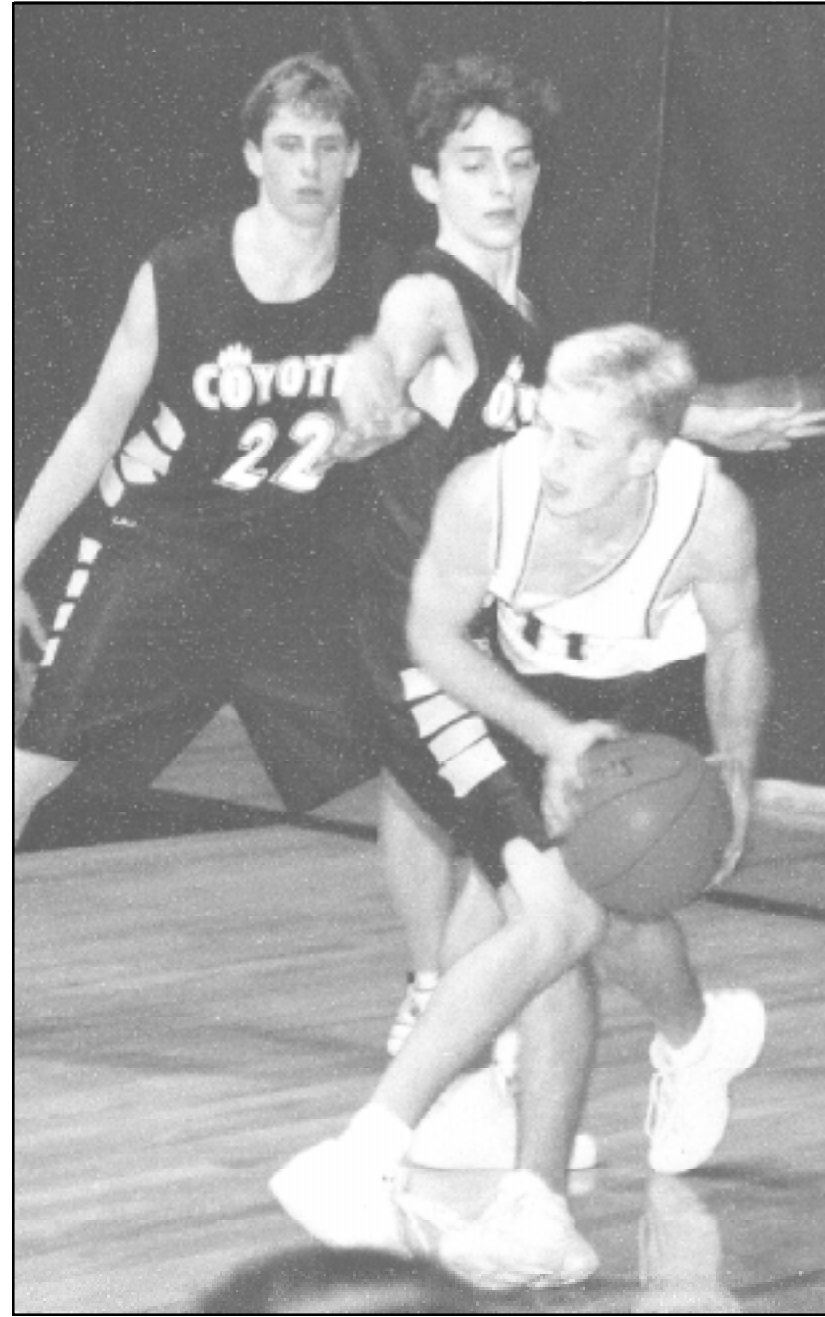
He was back a few minutes later and spent the rest of the game on the sideline with an icebag on his thumb.

"With my dominant hand gone ... I didn't go out there to score 21. I just

wanted to help my team," said Rush, who had a light cast on the thumb for support.

With Rush a non-factor, the Jayhawks (23-5, 12-4 Big 12) used a 21-7 run midway through the second half to erase a 31-30 halftime deficit and split their season series with their border rivals for the sixth straight year.

"It's always good to beat Missouri," said center Eric Chenoweth.
