

# Brewster moves step closer to class 1A title

HAYS — The Brewster High School boys moved a step closer to repeating as Class 1A state basketball champions with a 57-39 win Thursday over Baileyville-B&B in the quarterfinal round of the state tournament in Hays. Quarterfinal action is sudden death, so both teams knew that a loss meant a trip home.

The 'Dawgs opened with a pressure defense, creating a lot of turnovers and giving up a few themselves. First blood was drawn by Brewster on a shot by Brett Arnberger with 6:31 on the clock. Justin Jamison scored on a steal to make it 4-0. At the 4:30 mark, Brewster was up 12-3 and with two minutes left in the period it was 18-9. Baileyville managed to get themselves back in the game, but trailed 23-17 at the end of one. It looked like Brewster was on a pace for 100 points. The Brewster defense gave the Falcons fits in the second period. Baileyville's first basket came at the 3:45 mark and they were outscored 16-9. An attempt by Baileyville to run out the clock and score the last bucket failed when Jay Reid intercepted a pass and sent the ball downcourt for an Arnberger lay-up at the buzzer. Brewster led 39-26. The third quarter started slowly: the first points were scored two minutes into the period. Baileyville tried a control offense and a press on defense with a little success, but the 'Dawgs managed to stay firmly in front, leading 47-35 at the buzzer. In the final period, the 'Dawgs didn't allow a Falcon bucket for nearly four minutes, while scoring two of their

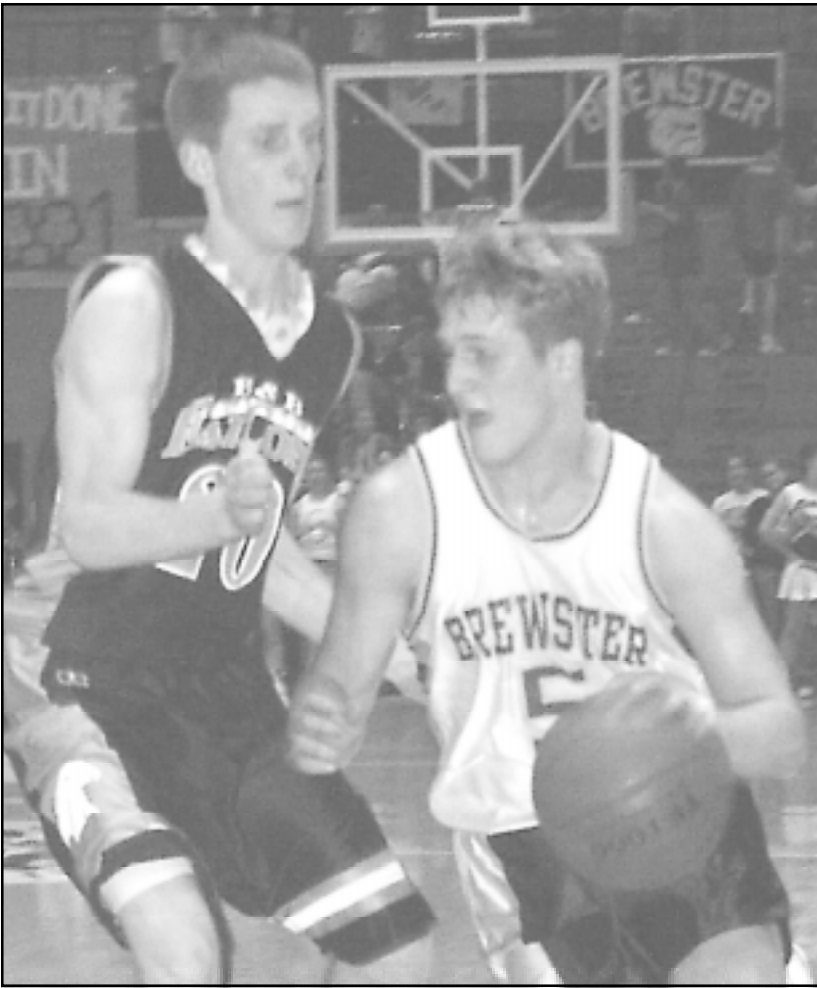

own. Coach Larry O'Connor cleared the bench at the one minute mark and the reserves scored three to make the final 57-39. Jamison led the scoring and boards with 14 points and four rebounds. He also had two assists and a team high four steals. Reid had 12 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals. P.J. Crum-

baker had 11 points, three rebounds, three assists and three steals. Clint Horinek had 10 points, three rebounds and a steal. Arnberger had six points, an assist and two steals. Bobby Tubbs had two points. J.R. Baird had two rebounds and both Rob Garner and Travis Dixon had one. Jacob Falcon had one assist. Brewster shot 44 percent from the

field and 58 from the charity stripe. The 'Dawgs take on league rival Tribune in the semi-finals tonight. Game time is 7:15 p.m. Mountain Time at Gross Memorial Coliseum in Hays. The winner will be in the championship game at 5:15 p.m. Mountain Time Saturday, and the loser will be in the consolation game at 1 p.m. Mountain Time Saturday.

## Rockies overcome Anaheim Angels, 6-3

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP) — Todd Walker went 2-for-2 and drove in the go-ahead run Thursday as the Colorado Rockies overcame Mike Hampton's rough first inning to defeat an Anaheim Angels' split squad 6-3.

In the first, Hampton gave up three hits and three runs, two on Larry Barnes' second homer of the spring, but retired nine of the 10 batters he faced over the next three innings. Hampton, who signed a \$121 million, eight-year contract with Colorado, pitched three perfect innings in his first start. The Rockies scored in the first on an RBI single by Todd Helton and cut the Angels' lead to 3-2 on a sacrifice fly by Larry Walker in the sixth. Colorado took the lead with three runs in the seventh. Mark Little and Todd Hollandsworth hit back-to-back doubles to tie the game. Todd Walker singled to drive in Hollandsworth, and Darren Cox, who was hit by a pitch, scored on a ground out by Juan Uribe. The Rockies added a run in the eighth when Brooks Kieschnick scored on a double play after his lead-off double.
