DENVER (AP) — Leon Lett, the defensive tackle who was a dominant run-stopper for the Dallas Cowboys, has agreed to a contract with the Denver Broncos, Denver television stations reported Monday.

Broncos spokesman Richard Stewart said Monday he could not confirm the deal, which the TV stations said was for four years at \$9 million. "Nothing had been done as of today," Stewart said.

Lett's agent, Jim Steiner, did not immediately return a phone call, and Cowboys spokesman Rich Dalrymple could not be reached for comment.

Lett, 32, was selected to the Pro Bowl in 1994 and 1998.
