Lloyd Eldon Snowbarger

Lloyd Eldon Snowbarger, 83, Burlington, Colo., a former Goodland resident, died Friday, March 23, 2001, at Burlington, Colo., following a lengthy illness.

He was born May 27, 1917, in Goodland, the son of Viola and Robert Snowbarger.

He grew up on a farm in western Kansas. He graduated from high school when he was 16 and became a mechanic.

He and Koy Thomas were married May 17, 1941, at Baxter Springs.

He served in the U.S. Army for three years during World War II and earned a Bronze Star.

In 1945, the couple moved to Burlington and he worked as a mechanic. In 1953, he went to work for Hudson Chevrolet in Burlington as a car salesman. Later, he became a partner in the business. He retired in 1982.

He was a member of the Goodland Elks Lodge, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion.

He enjoyed hunting and fishing, playing bridge and dominoes and cheering for the Colorado University Buffaloes.

His funeral service will be at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at First St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Burlington with Pastor Wesley Dunbar officiating. Burial will be in the Fairview Cemetery at Burlington.

Survivors include a son, Kent Snowbarger of Grand Junction, Colo.; two daughters, Karen Snowbarger of Broomfield, Colo., and Kathy Sitzman of Cheyenne, Wyo.; two sisters, Roberta Linin and Donna Lee Short; four grandchildren; 15 nieces and nephews; and 22 great nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his wife; a daughter, Konnie, in 1952; his parents; and his stepfather, Roy Fixsen.

Memorials may be made to First St. Paul's Lutheran Church or Caring Hands Hospice and left at the Bank of Burlington.
