# Defensive tackle returns to 49ers after three years

SANTA CLARA, Calif. (AP) — Dana Stubblefield has returned to the 49ers.

San Francisco signed Stubblefield, a free agent released by the Washington Redskins last month, to a six-year deal on Thursday.

The 6-foot-2, 290-pound Stubblefield spent five seasons with the 49ers — teamed with fellow defensive tackle Bryant Young — before leaving for Washington in 1998.

San Francisco general manager Bill Walsh was excited to have the duo back together again. Added to the mix was defensive end Andre Carter, the 49ers' top pick, seventh overall, in last week's draft.

"We feel we'll have as good as, or the best, combination of defensive

tackles in football," Walsh said. "I'm just excited about the first day these guys are in the huddle together, and that includes Andre Carter. I don't want to put any pressure on our coach, but, gosh, this is a real turnaround defensively."

Accompanied by his wife, Kim, Stubblefield was all smiles as he donned a 49ers cap at the team's training facility.

"It's just something I've been dreaming about for a long time, something I never thought would happen again," he said.

Stubblefield, a three-time Pro Bowl selection and 1997's Defensive Player of the Year, has 393 tackles, 46.5 sacks, 15 passes defended and two interceptions over an eight-year pro career.

# Kansas' athletic director steps down

LAWRENCE (AP) — Athletic directors just don't have as much fun as they used to, says the man who hired Roy Williams and then fell into disfavor for dropping two sports.

So Bob Frederick is stepping down effective June 30 after 14 years at Kansas.

"I'm 61 years old now and I've spent a lot of time in this job and it's gotten a lot harder in the last few years," he said Thursday.

"Sports-talk shows, the Internet, chat rooms — all those things have made it more difficult for head coaches and ADs and even for chancellors. I'm looking forward to being out on the farm and spending more time with my family."

Frederick, a widely respected collegiate administrator, ran into mounting criticism after deciding three months ago to drop men's tennis and swimming. Eliminating the sports in a cost-cutting move which he said was desperately needed triggered outrage among many
