CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 19

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 16 OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Goodland, Kansas, by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby repeals Charter Ordinance No. 16 of the City of Goodland, Kansas, passed on the 16th day of February, 1988.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper as provided by law.

Section 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after the last publication there of unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case
