AN ORDINANCE REGULAT-ING THE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE **CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE** CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS: **INCORPORATING BY REFER-ENCE THE "STANDARD TRAF-FIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS** CITIES," EDITION OF 2001; PRO-VIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND AMENDING AND REPEAL-**ING SECTION 16-101 OF THE** CODE OF THE CITY OF GOOD-LAND.

BEIT ORDAINED BY THE GOV-ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDI-**NANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland. Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance clerk to be open to inspection and for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2001, prepared and published in sonable hours. book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1456,' and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. BEITORDAINED BY THE GOV-ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING

UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2001, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka. Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1457," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city available to the public at all rea-
