**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2001; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION 16-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:**

**Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2001, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1457," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

**Section 2. REPEAL.** Section 16-101 of the Code of the City of Goodland, is hereby amended and repealed.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

### ORDINANCE NO. 1457

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF**

**THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2001; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION 12-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:**

**Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.** There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2001, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1457," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

**Section 2. REPEAL.** Section 12-101 of the Code of the City of Goodland is hereby amended and repealed.

**Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
