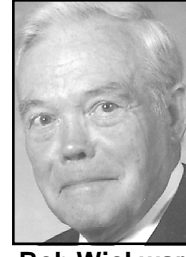
Robert P. Wickwar

Funeral services for longtime Goodland resident Robert "Bob" Wickwar will be held at First Christian Church in Goodland on Friday, July 20, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. Wickwar, 94, died Tuesday, July 17, 2001 at the Goodland Regional Medical Center where he had been a patient for the past seven weeks.

He was born August 17, 1906 in Kirwin, Kan., to Percy and Clara (Scott) Wickwar.

Bob graduated from Goodland High School. He married Fern Sherrod in Goodland on June 30, 1929. Bob worked for the U.S. Postal Service as a mail carrier for 30 years. After he retired from that job in the early 1970's he continued working with and helping people.

When his wife became very ill he cared for her in the home until her

death. He then rejoined the work force working at McDonalds, Goodland Good Samaritan Center, Goodland Regional Medical Center as a CNA and in the physical therapy department, as well as other places where he was needed. Bob enjoyed telling stories from his past of his family, and was an accomplished vocalist, singing Tenor with the Morrell Chorus as well as many solos whenever he was asked. He was a member of the Rural Mail Carriers Association, First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Goodland where he had been given an Elder Emeritus position. He also participated in the Lions Club in his younger days. Bob and his family lived in many areas including Chandler and Sun City, Ariz.; Ottumwa, Iowa; Colorado Springs Colo.; and Plattsburg and Cameron, Mo. but he

always kept returning to Goodland, his true home.

Wickwar is survived by two sons Sherrod R and wife Carol of Green Valley, Ariz., Richard N. and wife Jill of Fort Washington, Md.; two sisters Marcelline Wilson of Eldorado, Kan., and Ruby Hawes of Denver; 11 grandchildren, 25 great grandchildren; 3 great great grandchildren; and a host of nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Fern, one son Lewis, 3 brothers Ernie, Bud, and Bill, and 5 sisters Lizzie, Ruth, Agnes, Mildred, and Dora.

Pastor Loren Strait will officiate. Burial will follow at the Goodland Cemetery. 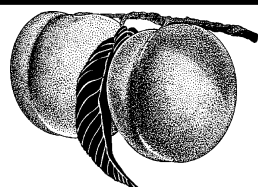

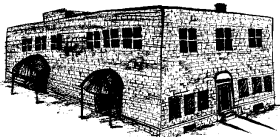

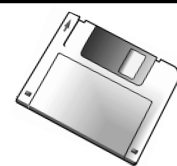
