NOTICE OF FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

It has been determined that such request for release of funds will not constitute an action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment and, accordingly the KDOC&H has decided not to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (P.L. 91-190).

The reasons for such decision not to prepare such Statement are as follows:

Compatible with surrounding land uses & no adverse impact on the environment.

An Environmental Review Record respecting the within project has been made by the KDOC&H which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the above address and is available for public examination and copying, upon request, at 700 SW Harrison, between the hours of 8:00 am and 5 pm.

No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted, prior to the request for release of Federal Funds.

All interested agencies, groups and person disagreeing with this decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the KDOC&H. Such written comments should be received at 700 SW Harrison on or before 15 days after date of this Notice. All such comments so received will be considered and the KDOC&H will not request the release of Federal funds or take any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified in the preceding sentence.

NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

KDOC&H will undertake the project described above with

HOME funds from the U.S. HUD, under Title II of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990. KDOC&H is certifying to HUD that KDOC&H and Randy L. Speaker in his official capacity as Division of Housing Director, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making, and action: and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, KDOC&H may use the HOME Funds and will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. HUD will accept an objection to its approval of the release of funds and acceptance of the certification only if it is on one of the following bases: (a) that the certification was not in fact executed by the chief executive officer or other officer of applicant approved by KDOC&H; or (b) that applicant's Environmental Review Record for the project indicates omission of a required decision, finding, or step applicable to the project in the environmental review process. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedure (24 CFR Part 58), and may be addressed to HUD KS/MO State Office, Room 200, Gateway Tower II, 400 State Avenue, Kansas City, KS 66101-2406. Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by HUD. Objections must be submitted within 15 days following receipt of the Request for Release of Funds by HUD.
