**Sept. 11, 1901:** A car loaded with coal was pushed over the coal 'shute' Sunday morning, breaking completely in two about the middle, part remaining on the track and the other section fell to the ground. An engine in charge of Engineer Foster was backing cars upon the incline when the end car came uncoupled and went with sufficient force against the blocks at the end of the track to break them off. The acci-

dent was unavoidable and no blame is attached to the train crew. *From The Goodland Republic*; Information provided by The Sherman County Historical Society.
