RESOLUTION 01-1

A RESOLUTION ATTESTING TO AN INCREASE IN TAX REVENUES FOR BUDGET YEAR 2002 FOR THE SHERMAN COUNTY RURAL FIRE DISTRICT #1

WHEREAS, the Sherman County Rural Fire District #1 must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of to citizens of our county; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of this county continues to increase; and;

WHEREAS, the Kansas Legislature has cut growth in demand transfers to local governments below what is required by state statute; and

WHEREAS, The 2000 Kansas Legislature significantly reduced demand and transfer payments to local governments below last year's level;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sherman County Rural Fire District #1 Board of Sherman County:

Section One. In accordance with state law, the County of Sherman has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund county services from January 1, 2002 until December 31, 2002.

Section Two. After careful public deliberation, the Sherman County Rural Fire District #1 Board has determined that in order to maintain the public services which are essential for the citizens of this county, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the 2001 budget.

Section Three. This resolution shall take effect after publication once in the official newspaper

From the Southwest corner of said section, thence South 87°52'32" East 494.86 feet along southern line of said section; thence North 2°4'18" East 67.32 feet to a point on the north right-of-way line of Business Highway 24 also known as the point of beginning; thence North 2°42'0" East 573.93 feet to a point on the south right-of-way line of 19th Street; thence South 87°28'53" East 98.425 feet along south right-of-way line of 19th Street; thence South 2°42'0" west 573.25 feet to a point on the north right-of-way line of Business Highway 24; thence North 87°52'28" West 98.43 feet along the north right-of-way line of Business Highway 24 to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Said street is hereby named Cherry Street.

SECTION 3. After the passage and publication of this ordinance the same shall be filed with the Register of Deeds and County Clerk of Sherman County, Kansas.

SECTION 2. Said street is hereby named Pioneer Drive.

SECTION 3. After the passage and publication of this ordinance the same shall be filed with the Register of Deeds and County Clerk of Sherman County, Kansas.
