

Diamondbacks win Series of twists

PHOENIX (AP)—Mariano Rivera was on the mound, the Yankees' clubhouse was being set up for a champagne celebration and the Arizona Diamondbacks were in trouble.

"We were done," Arizona's Mark Grace said.

Yet in a World Series full of late twists, David Dellucci thought there might be

one more in Game 7. He said so in the Diamondbacks' dugout Sunday night.

"I looked over at Grace and said, 'Man, it's time for us to create our own magic,'" he said.

Did they ever.

In a stunning comeback, Luis Gonzalez blooped an RBI single that capped a two-run rally in the bottom of

the ninth inning off Rivera, and the Diamondbacks beat New York 3-2 to win their first championship.

"I wouldn't move on the bench. I wanted to get up and watch for the whole inning, but I was playing the luck seat," Arizona pitcher Curt Schilling said.

"It seemed pretty surreal to me, watching this all develop," fellow ace

Randy Johnson said.

Schilling and Johnson wound up as co-MVPs, accounting for all four Arizona victories.

The Yankees were only two outs from their fourth straight championship when it suddenly fell apart. Against the most dominant postseason reliever ever, no less.

Director fires coach vows to raise Jayhawks

LAWRENCE (AP)—Terry Allen, the only coach in Kansas history to keep his job after four straight losing seasons, could not make it through a fifth.

Vowing to raise the lowly Jayhawks to the top of the Big 12, athletic director Al Bohl announced Sunday that Allen had been dismissed, effective immediately. Defensive coordinator and secondary coach Tom Hayes will be in charge the final three games but has no guarantee beyond that.

Allen, 20-33 at Kansas and increasingly unpopular with alumni, urged everyone to get behind the new coach.

"I'm sorry we were not successful," Allen said, sitting alongside wife Lynn while Bohl and Hayes waited to come to the front of the room and speak.

"We did our best and didn't fulfill what we needed to do. Success in this league is very difficult."

Under intense pressure to deliver a winning season in Bohl's first season as his boss, Allen, 44, faced a schedule the NCAA certified as the toughest in the country.

Besides Big 12 powers Nebraska, Oklahoma, Kansas State and Texas, the Jayhawks also played UCLA. A 51-7 loss to No. 2 Nebraska Saturday night

—after he had already been told he was fired — left the Jayhawks 2-6 overall and 1-5 in the conference.

"We stumbled early on some things we needed to do. But the reality of the situation is, this is the toughest league in college football," Allen said.

Bohl, who led revivals of the Toledo and Fresno State programs in lesser conferences, said he would tolerate nothing less than championship football.



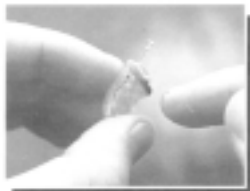
