SECTION 1. Defini-

tions.

A. Alley or Alleyway. A street or highway intended to provide access to the rear or side of lots or buildings in urban districts and not intended for the purpose of through vehicular traffic.

B. Motor Vehicle. Every vehicle, other than a motorized bicycle or a motorized wheelchair, which is self-propelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon rails.

D. Person. Every natural person, firm, association, partnership or corporation.

E. Recreational Vehicle. A vehicular-type unit built on or for use on a chassis and designed primarily as living quarters for recreational, camping, vacation or travel use and which has its own motive power or is mounted on or drawn by another vehicle; but such term shall not include a unit which has no electrical system which operates above 12 volts and has no provisions for plumbing, heating and any other compo-

H. Trailer. Every vehicle with use by the public, the City of or without motive power, other than a pole trailer, designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a erations, may remove and motor vehicle, and so constructed that no part of its weight rests upon the towing vehicle.

I. Heavy Truck. Every motor C. Park or Parking. Means the vehicle designed, used, or maintained primarily for the transportation of property with a manufacturer's G.V.W.R. of 12,000lbs or greater.

> J. Truck Tractor. Every motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn

> K. Vehicle. Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

> SECTION 2. Except as hereinafter provided, no person shall park or store any
