K-State loses to Huskers

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) Nebraska's game against Kansas State was expected to be for the Big 12 North championship.

As it turns out, it was only a preliminary round.

The second-ranked Cornhuskers beat the Wildcats 31-21 Saturday to stay on top of the North, but Nebraska still needs to beat Colorado (8-2, 6-1) Nov. 23 to advance to the conference title game.

A loss at Colorado would mean no Big 12 title game Dec. 1 and would seriously hamper Nebraska's hopes for the national championship.

Although Kansas State (4-5, 2-5) has slipped from the top of the division, the Wildcats came about as close as anybody has to stopping the Huskers this vear.
