You have the right to appear and object through your own counsel. If you timely file objections, you may appear and be heard at the hear ing to determine the fairness and adequacy of the proposed settlement, to be held at 9:00 A.M. on December 18, 2001, in the courtroom of Judge Gary L. McAliley, Circuit of Coffee County-Enterprise Division, Enterprise, Alabama

The plaintiffs in this case contend that the Defendants have breached contracts with and made misrepresentations to the Settlement Class Members regarding their cellular telephone service and related charges. Defendants deny any and all liability with respect to the matters alleged in the complaint and deny that they have violated any laws.
