Legislator says cut spending

The 2002 legislative session began ast week, and the state's tight budget eems to be the main focus.

Gov. Bill Graves outlined a plan on Monday during his the State of the State ddress to raise \$228 million through xtra taxes on sales, cigarettes, motor uel and vehicle registration. He said ne increases were needed to close the ap between expected revenue and pending commitments.

Rep. Jim Morrison, who represents Goodland and Colby, said he isn't thrilled about the idea. Taxes shouldn't be raised, he said, because there is no reason Kansas should have a budget deficit.

"The state has s much money this year, or more, than ast," he said. "There is no reason to cut

ervices or to raise taxes.

"We haven't grown as fast as we lanned, but we do have money."

Morrison said he is opposed to Graves' proposal to raise taxes. He says ne state should instead concentrate on ontrolling its spending.

Morrison claims that the state wastes 6-7 million a year on programs and xpenses it doesn't need.

Buying buildings, building underround parking lots and increasing the umber of consultants on the public ayroll have all got to stop, he says.


"We have a top-heavy administration n this state," he said. "I am tired of it.
