ORDINANCE NO. 1479 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION 3-104 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS PERTAINING TO THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: No person shall drink or consume any alcoholic liquor on City owned public property. However with the prior consent of the Goodland City Commission this prohibition shall not apply to the Goodland Arts Council Building located at 12" and Center in the City of Goodland, and the Goodland Municipal Airport Administration Building located at 596 Airport Road, which is property owned by the City.

SECTION 2: Section 3-104 of the Code of the City of Goodland is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after publication in the official city newspaper.
