Sherman County will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 10, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. MDT at the Sherman County Commission Room 101, 813 Broadway, Goodland, Kansas, for the purpose of considering an application to be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Community Facilities category. A specific project application to be discussed is the replacement of a substandard bridge crossing the Middle Fork, Beaver Creek located 15.5 miles west of Goodland or just east of Kanorado on County Road 64/Old Highway 24, to serve an area generally bounded by portions of State Line and Lincoln Townships in Sherman County. A specific target area map can be seen at the Sherman County Clerk's office. Work will consist of the removal of the existing bridge and the construction of a new reinforced concrete naunched slab bridge, and the necessary clearing and grubbing, excavating, compacting and seeding. The estimated total project cost is \$465,884 with the grant request. For \$99,000 of the project cost. Other project proposals introduced at the hearing will be considered. Oral and written comments will be recorded and become a part of the County's CDBG Citizen Participation Plan. Reasonable accommodations will be made available to persons with disabilities. Requests should be submitted to the County Clerk's Office by September 9, 2002.
