High Plains Museum Commemorates September 11th

The High Plains Museum is participating in a community observance for the first anniversary of September 11th. This, in a joint effort between the American Association of Museums (AAM) and the Institute of Museums and Library Services (IMLS) to promote Museums Celebrate America's Freedoms: A Day of Remembrance. AAM and Home Box Office (HBO) has provided us, at no cost, a copy of HBO's well-received documentary film on the events of September 11, IN MEMORIAM: NEW YORK CITY, 9/11/01.

The museum will be showing the film two times during the day, Wednesday, September 11th. The first showing at 10:30 a.m. and second at 3 p.m. Children should not view this. The film contains some difficult and graphic scenes but concludes on a hopeful note. It is a remarkable collection of firsthand views of the events of September 11 in New York, a witness of that history.

There will also be a large panel/mural available allowing visitors to share their reflections and thoughts. Sherman County residents are encouraged to participate. Carol Tupper's quilts will also be on display.

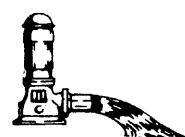
