ORDINANCE NO. 1490

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING PROPERTY AS PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF GOODLAND.

ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423 the City declares as open the following described street:

A tract of Land located in the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Eight (8) South, Range Thirty-nine (39), West of the 6th P.M. in Sherman County, Kansas, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Section, thence, on assumed bearing of N89°59'36"E, along the south line of said Section, a distance of five hundred seventy and fifty-seven hundredths (570.57) feet and N00°34'58"E for a distance of five hundred seventy-two and no hundredths (572.00) feet to the point of beginning, said point of beginning being located thirty and no hundredths (30.00) feet south of the south right-of-way line of 19th Street.


