Strike continues in Venezula Prime time

CARACAS, Venezuela—Ageneral strike aimed at ousting leftist President Hugo Chavez sparked panic buying across Venezuela as it entered its second week today, pushing the national guard to commandeer delivery trucks and force gas stations to open.

The indefinite strike has crippled the oil industry of the world's fifth-largest producer as wells, refineries, tanker ships, delivery centers and gas stations have stopped operating in a gradual shutdown that would take weeks to

Chavez sent soldiers to protect oil wells and refineries from possible sabotage by strikers last week. On Sunday, he sent national guard troops to open gas stations in the capital and seized the trucks of striking delivery companies.

"They are failing to provide a public service, and that's a crime," Chavez said during a five-hour-plus edition of his weekly television and radio program, "Hello President."
