NEW YORK (AP) — Tampa Bay linebacker Derrick Brooks is the crown jewel of the NFL's best defense and easily topped Miami end Jason Taylor for The Associated Press NFL Defensive Player of the Year award.  
Brooks led his team in tackles (170) for the fifth consecutive year and led the NFL with three interception returns for TDs.
