

# Violence escalates in Israel

JERUSALEM (AP) — In rapidly escalating violence just two weeks before Israel's general election, seven Palestinians, two other Arab attackers and two Israelis were killed in raids and infiltrations in a 24-hour period.

Israeli Defense Minister Shaul Mofaz was evasive when asked about reports that he is planning to step up strikes against Palestinian militants. Mofaz said Israel is facing a growing wave of terror, but that there would be "nothing very much out of the ordinary" in Israel's response.

Palestinian officials have accused Prime Minister Ariel Sharon of escalating military action to deflect attention from corruption allegations that have been hurting his

re-election bid. Two Israeli opinion polls indicated today that Sharon's Likud party is recovering somewhat from a monthlong drop in support.

VIENNA, Austria (AP) — By boosting its nominal crude output by 1.5 million barrels a day, OPEC hopes to reassure markets roiled by a shortfall in Venezuelan exports and the possibility of war in Iraq.

The Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries decided Sunday to increase its production target by 6.5 percent, to 24.5 million barrels a day. OPEC seeks to push oil prices back below its maximum price target of \$28 a barrel. Prices hovered around \$30 on Friday.

The additional crude should bring some modest relief to consumers in importing countries, analysts said. The United States welcomed the move, saying the hike would support economic growth and stability.

"It's a global oil market and the more oil on the market the better for all," U.S. Energy Department spokeswoman Jeanne Lopatto said Sunday. "Instability in the oil market hurts producing and consuming countries alike."

OPEC said it wanted to calm fears of a supply crunch caused by an ongoing general strike in Venezuela. The agreed output hike was near the upper end of what analysts had expected.

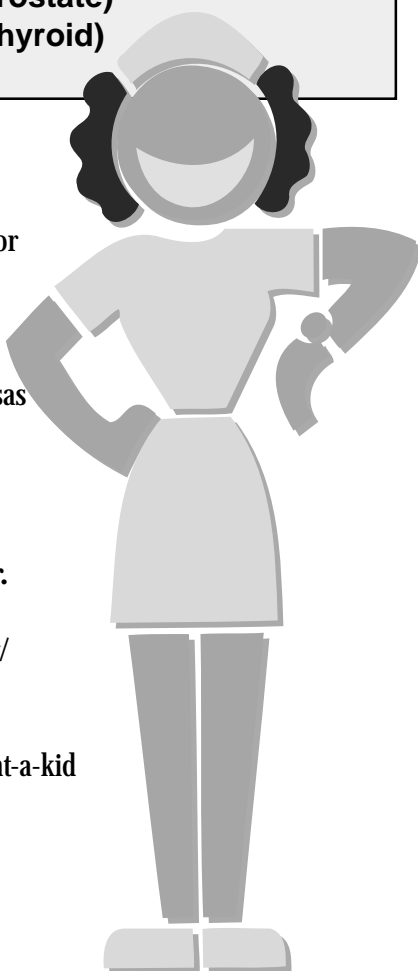
**Blood profiles will be done prior to the fair at the Goodland Regional Medical Center. Results will be distributed at the fair February 1st.**
