In all-too-common-fashion, the Sharon Springs girls lost another game that could have gone either way Tuesday night at home against the Syracuse Bulldogs, 59-57.

Early on, the Wildcats simply dominated the Bulldogs, jumping out to an 8-0 lead before Syracuse finally hit a three-pointer.

But that three-pointer was the first of many for the Bulldogs in the first half as they fought back to take the lead 25-24 with 2:02 left in the first half.

Ashley Bruce got the lead back momentarily for the Wildcats early in the third quarter with her second trey of the game.

A great assist from sophomore Sarah Hill to Brandi Bertrand on the inside for a basket helped Sharon Springs keep pace with Syracuse.

Another highlight of the third quarter was a pass from Darci Siebert to Bruce for a lay-up.

Siebert had a defender on her and her back to the basket, but somehow managed to see Bruce cut to the basket behind her.

Siebert delivered a bounce pass to Bruce exactly on target and it

brought the score to 37-36.

It looked like Syracuse was starting to pull away at the end of the third quarter, but as time ran down, Bruce calmly faked a three-point shot to get her defender off balance, then took one dribble and sank the shot to pull the Wildcats back within one as the buzzer sounded.

The intensity never died down and once again it looked like Syracuse was going to wrap up the win. They led 57-53 with one minute
