

Cowgirls first, boys second at LaCrosse

The Goodland High track team made up for a missed opportunity with an unscheduled trip to LaCrosse on Tuesday, with Cowgirls recording a first place finish and the Cowboys taking second.

Ten teams competed in the meet, which was not on Goodland's original schedule. However, after the first meet of the year in Ogallala, Neb., was snowed out, Coach Dennis Stone said that he was planning to find another event for his team.

He found it in LaCrosse, a school in the middle of the state at the junction of U.S. 56 and U.S. 281.

Other schools traveling to LaCrosse were — Otis-Bison, which took first in the boys division, Ellis, Eastern Heights, Kinsley, Ness City, Pawnee Heights, Dighton, Bazine and Dighton.

The Goodland girls ran off with the 200-meter dash, with Rebecca Gattshall, Jaci Stone and Whitney Carmichael taking first, second and third.

Gattshall and Carmichael took first and second in the 100 meters, while Stone ran first in the 400. Alisha McKee took the gold in the shot put.

For the boys, Dan Melia was first in the 110-meter hurdles.
