While the final scores makes it sound as if the Cowgirls coasted to the victories, they had to work hard for their runs, especially in the second game.

Girls fourth in Scott City Relays

The Goodland High girls track team came in fourth and the boys sixth in the Class 3A-4A Division of the Scott City Relays on Tuesday.

The Colby girls took first with 113.5 points, followed by Scott City, 90.5; Lakin, 76; and Goodland, 74. In the boys end of the contest, Scott City took first with 100; followed by Lakin, 99; Oakley, 74; Norton, 72; Ulysses, 68; and Goodland, 64.

Ness City took first in Class 1A-2A Division for the boys and the girls.

While the Goodland girls team finished higher overall than the boys, the girls did not take any firsts while the boys had three, including a school record set by Jordan Bedore in the discus with a distance of 165 feet, 3 inches.

The girls came home with four seconds, a tie for third and several fourth, fifths and sixths.
