

Cowboys fourth, Cowgirls ninth at Holcomb meet

The Goodland High Cowboys took fourth place and the Cowgirls ninth at the Holcomb Invitational Track Meet on Friday.

The Scott City boys won the meet with 81 points. Lakin was second with 78 and Ulysses third with 63. Goodland had 57 points.

The Ness City girls took the top spot with a commanding 108 points. They were followed by Lakin, 69; Colby, 62; Sublette, 52; Hugoton, 46; Holcomb, 44; Ulysses, 39; Moscow, 36; and Goodland, 31.5.

Other teams attending the meet were the Garden City junior varsity, Southwestern Heights, Cimarron and Granada, Colo.

Jayci Stone was the only Goodland athlete to take first place. She won the pole vault with a 10-foot jump. She also took the girl's only second place.

Taylor Brack and Lance Tedford took second places for the boys.
