# Cowboys win Tri-State; Cowgirls come in second

The Goodland High Cowboys won their home track meet and the Cowgirls came in second at the annual Tri-State Relays on Friday.

The boys edged Scott City by one point to win the meet. Goodland had 93 points; Scott City, 92; Ulysses, 84; Colby, 66; and Ogallala, Neb., 32.

The Colby girls had a strong lead with 115 points to take the No. 1 spot, followed by Goodland, 79; Scott City, 73; Ulysses, 55; and Ogallala, 46.

Wheeler of Scott City threw a new boys relay record in the discus with a 55-foot, 10.5-inch toss.

Rebecca Gattshall, Kara Angelos, Andrea Fenner and Jayci Stone took first place awards for the Goodland girls and Bret Jarmin, Lance Tedford and a relay team took firsts for the boys.
