

Cowboys take second at Colby; Girls edged out by one for third

Girls unable to pick up any medals for first place

The Goodland High boys track team took second and the girls fourth in the Colby track meet on Friday.

Only Ulysses with 120 points beat out the Goodland boys, who had 106. Colby came in third with 65, Oakley fourth with 54 and Syracuse last with 28.

The Colby girls won their own meet with 132 points, followed by Syracuse, 79; Ulysses, 68; Goodland, 67; and Oakley, 27.

The boys did well on the strength of six first-place finishes, five seconds and four thirds.

Uncharacteristically, the girls were unable to claim any firsts. They did get six seconds and six thirds, however, to miss third place by a single point.

Brewster track teams compete at meets in St. Francis, Quinter

The Brewster High track team attended a meet in St. Francis on April 29 and both the boys and girls brought home 11th place.

Amy Carpenter and Mark Luckert were the high finishers for the Bulldogs. Each took second — Carpenter in the shot put and Luckert in the 1,600-meter run.

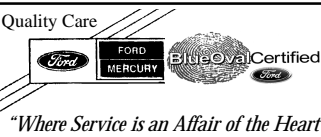

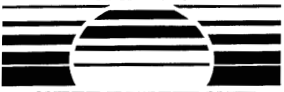
