# One-hit shutout tops ball action as Lakin falls to Goodland

The Goodland-St. Francis Outlaws baseball team won two games from the Lakin High School junior varsity on May 5, 11-0 and 12-4.

Landon West pitched a one-hit shutout in the first game against Lakin. He stuck out 16, including the last 10 Lakin batters, giving up one walk and a single in six innings.

While West was keeping the Lakin Broncs off the bases, the Outlaws bats were putting men on.

In the first inning, the Outlaws had three singles, a double and got a man on base on an error. Two men stole second and one third and they had four runs.

In the second, they only had one base hit and the man was later picked off.

An error by the Lakin team allowed an Outlaw on base in the third. He stole second and a base hit brought him home.

In the fourth, the Outlaws were ahead 5-0 but were unable to add to the total despite a single and a stolen base.

The fifth inning was better as the Lakin pitcher walked two Outlaws and the team had four singles to bring in four runs and take the score to 9-0.

In the last inning, the Outlaws had

a walk, a base hit, a batter hit by a pitch and one put on base through an error.

After West struck out the Lakin team one, two, three, the Outlaws had an 11-0 win.

Kevin Schulte had a single, two walks and a stolen base; Caleb Rieger, a single; Travis Hilt, a pair of singles and an RBI; Landon West, three singles, three RBIs and a pair of stolen bases; Brock Lohr, a single and was hit by the pitcher; Jake Alander, a double, a single, four RBIs and a stolen base; Brandon Zelfer, a walk; Tyrel Rall, a single and a stolen base; and Lane Winter, a single. Wyatt Dautel also played.

In the second game, Lohr came on as pitcher. He was able to get four strikeouts but had five walks, hit two batters and allowed six base hits.

In the first inning, the Outlaws had a base hit and a steal. Then West hit a home run to put two on the board.

In the second, the Outlaws started out with a double then had an RBI sacrifice and a walk to add a run to their side of the scoreboard.

Lakin got on the board in the second inning but were wiped off the

bases in a double play and the score was 3-1 in favor of the Outlaws.

In the third, the Outlaws got one man on through an error but were not able to get him home. Lakin added a run to their side for a 3-2 ball game.

In the fourth, Lakin tried to give the game away by allowing three Outlaws on base due to errors. The Outlaws helped themselves with a base hit for three more runs.

After loading the bases with Lakin players, Lohr was able to get out of the bottom of the inning with no damage done. The score was 6-2.

In the fifth the, Outlaws added a run on a double and a single. Lakin added a pair to their score for a 7-4 game.

In the sixth, the Outlaws added five runs on a triple, a double, three base hits and a walk.

Schulte had a single, a triple, a stolen base and an RBI; West, a home run, a double, a single and a pair of RBIs; Alander, a double; Zelfer, a double, a single and three RBIs; Dautel, a single, a walk and a pair of RBIs; Winter, a walk; Hilt, a single; and Rall, a single and an RBI. Lohr, Rieger and Derek Fenner also played.

Randi Miller of Rapid City, S.D., kicked off the sprint car season 1st weekend by winning the season opening event at Black Hills Speedway. C.J. Johnson of Quinter, who finished second last weekend, is expected to be in Goodland to defend his home state turf against the rest of the Rocky Mountain Region invaders.

Other top sprint car regulars expected for Saturday's racing include defending champion Mike

Dreiling of Highlands Ranch, Colo., Eric Miller, Jace Pennetta and Nick Haygood.

Saturday's event marks the second of 26 nights of racing for the sprint cars this year throughout South Dakota, Kansas, Wyoming, New Mexico, Colorado and Montana.

Landon West had a standout day at the plate, slugging two home runs and a stolen base, collecting four runs batted in.

Kevin Schulte pitched a two-hitter in the first game for the Outlaws on May 8. He had four strikeouts and walked five. Ellis got only a single and a double off of him.

In the first inning, the Outlaws got a single and a stolen base, producing one run.

In the second, a double, a sacrifice and a base hit brought in the second Outlaw run.

The Outlaws started out the third
