

Brewster to hold city-wide cleanup day Monday

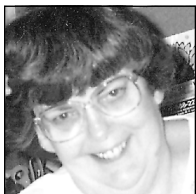
Here's a notice to everyone that on Monday, June 23, there will be a city-wide cleanup day with pick up of all cumbersome trash.
