Fan devoted years to Legion Baseball

The Goodland Star-News Each crack of an American Legion bat is a part of Kenneth Dautel's legacy.

In 1993, Dautel, Norman Gordan to keep the American Legion team going and continue the path of Bill Becker. Becker was an American Legion member who loved baseball and did everything but coach, selling tickets, working the concession stand and whatever he could do to support the team.

Merna Dautel says she remembers her husband going out to play ball every Sunday in Edson during the early years of their marriage. That passion for the game and love of children is the main reason Kenneth worked to keep the team alive.

Dautel's son John, who is coaching the team this season, says he wants to keep working the kids for the eight or nine years that his children will be active participants.

'My dad always had a love for baseball and really loved kids," John Dautel said. "He always wanted to be involved with activities for the kids, which makes me a lot like him."

The trees on the south side of Goodland's new Memorial field have been planted in his memory.

"We wanted to put up something useful in Ken's memory and these will provide shade and break the wind," Merna said.

The memorial fund for the senior and Malcom VanVleet got together Dautel, who died just a year ago Sunday, includes donations that go to the American Legion team and to Sherman County 4-H, of which Ken was also an strong supporter. Merna says money from the fund will be used to help out at the ball field as needed.

'They have a new microwave at the concession stand," she said, 'and whatever else they might need, all they have to do is ask."

Now, every generation of ball players will be able to remember Ken Dautel's contribution to the game just by going out to the new field. A plaque being purchased by this years' team will be hung in about a month next to one already up for Becker. The plaque will read 'Thank You Kenneth Dautel, American Legion baseball.'
